Education

Education has long been a priority of the Mill Reef Fund, supporting the island's youth through early childhood initiatives, vocational training for young adults and scholarship programs.

Religion

Religious organizations play a vital role in community life in Antigua and Barbuda. The Mill Reef Fund helps repair church facilities after hurricanes and supports church programs and the Archdiocese of the Caribbean.

Medical and Health


